**MAGISTRATE'S ORDER FOR EMERGENCY PROTECTION**

On this day, the Defendant, X Goss, Shajkia, appeared before the Court after arrest for an offense involving:

- X  Stalking under Section 42.072 of the Texas Penal Code.

**II. PROHIBITED ACTS**

It is hereby ORDERED that effective immediately, the Defendant (Date of birth: X 01.27.83, Driver's License # X6200765135072 MI) is prohibited from:

- Committing family violence or an assault on the person(s) protected under this Order;
- Committing an act in furtherance of an offense under Section 42.072 of the Texas Penal Code (Stalking);
- Communicating directly in a threatening or harassing manner with the person(s) protected under this Order or with any member of the family or household of the protected person(s);
- Communicating a threat through any person to the person(s) protected under the Order or to any member of the family or household of the protected person(s);

**III. CONFIDENTIALITY OF ADDRESSES**

Based on the facts presented, the Court further ORDERS that for the safety of all person(s) protected under the Order, the addresses and specific locations of the person(s) protected by the Order shall remain confidential and shall be omitted from the Order.

**IV. DELIVERY OF ORDER**

It is ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court send a copy of this Order to the:

- Chief of Police in the municipality where the person(s) protected under this Order or any member of the family or household of the protected person(s) resides;
- Sheriff or Constable of the county where the person(s) protected under this Order or of any member of the family or household of the protected person(s) resides;
- Principal, director, or person in charge of the school or childcare facility attended by a person(s) named herein and protected under this; and
- Victim.

**V. NOTICE TO THE VICTIM**

It is ORDERED that a law enforcement officer make a good faith effort to notify, within 24 hours, the victim named in this Order by calling said victim's residence and place of employment.

**VI. SUSPENSION OF CONCEALED HANDGUN LICENSE**

It is ORDERED that the license to carry a concealed handgun of \_\_\_\_\_ the Defendant, is suspended for the duration of the Order. A copy of this Order shall be forwarded to the Concealed Handgun Licensing Unit, Department of Public Safety, P. O. Box 4143, Austin, Texas 78765-4143.

On receipt of this Order suspending the license to carry a concealed handgun, the department shall record the suspension of the license, report the suspension to the local law enforcement agencies, as appropriate, and demand surrender of the suspended license from the license holder.

**VII. DURATION OF ORDER**

This Order is effective upon issuance and shall remain in full force and effect until MIDNIGHT on April 11, 2015. (this date should be no less than 31 days and up to 61 days from the date of issuance.)

THE POSSESSION OF A FIREARM BY A PERSON, OTHER THAN A PEACE OFFICER (AS DEFINED BY SECTION 1.07 OF THE TEXAS PENAL CODE) ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN EMPLOYMENT AS A SWORN, FULL-TIME PAID EMPLOYEE OF A STATE AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION, WHO IS SUBJECT TO THIS ORDER MAY BE PROSECUTED AS A SEPARATE OFFENSE PUNISHABLE BY CONFINEMENT OR IMPRISONMENT.

NO PERSON, INCLUDING A PERSON WHO IS PROTECTED BY THIS ORDER, MAY GIVE PERMISSION TO ANYONE TO IGNORE OR VIOLATE ANY PROVISION OF THIS ORDER. DURING THE TIME IN WHICH THIS ORDER IS VALID, EVERY PROVISION OF THIS ORDER IS IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT UNLESS A COURT CHANGES THE ORDER.






